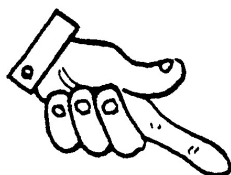
SEPT 27TH - HARVEST FESTIVAL SERVICE


- SEPT 13TH - BATTLE OF BRITAIN SUNDAY**
